The Alberta Institute of Agrologists is taking a leadership role in the natural resource professions in Alberta and for all of agrology across Canada. The AIA is the fastest growing professional association in Canada. If you want to be more directly a part of governance for the AIA, stand for election for the 2012 council.

There are 2 positions available for the 2012 elections:

- **RTAg at large (from anywhere in Alberta)**
- **PAg at large (from anywhere in Alberta)**

The Council is the key body that directs and influences all that the Institute does. The council operates with 11 council members. Three of these council members are appointed by the Alberta government as public members. These public members are the Institute “watch dogs” AND add a valuable component to a strong governing body. Eight council members are elected from the regulated member list of the profession.

1. Candidates need to provide a short 300 word bio (what they do, what they like to do, where they are from etc.) and answer the council candidate questions attached to the 2012 Council Nominations Document
- Here are some key activities and timeframes for council members: The position is a 3 year term
 - 5 meetings per year (see below)
 - January
 - March (in Banff at the AIA AGM)
 - June
 - October
 - December
 - There can be a few conference calls per year for key council decisions
 - There is about 2-4 hours of prep time prior to meetings, this is mostly reviewing monitoring reports that CEO submits quarterly

ALL Council meetings are held in Edmonton. Expenses and travel are paid for by the AIA.
